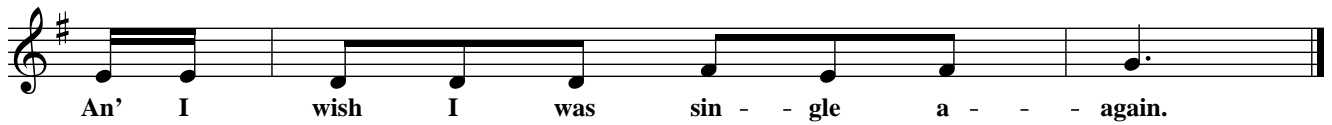


I wish I was Single Again
