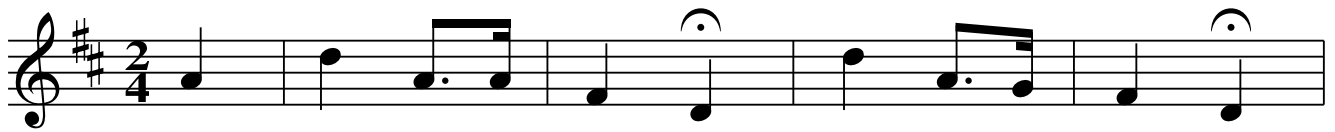


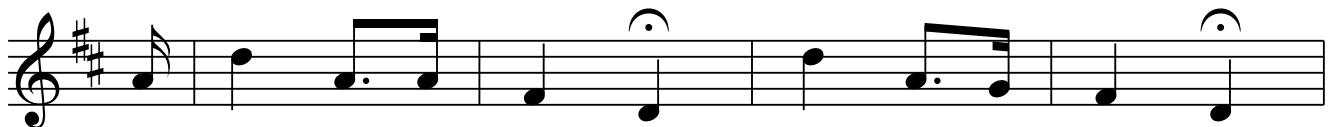
The Lily-white Boys

When the one is left a - lone he ev - er - more shall be so.



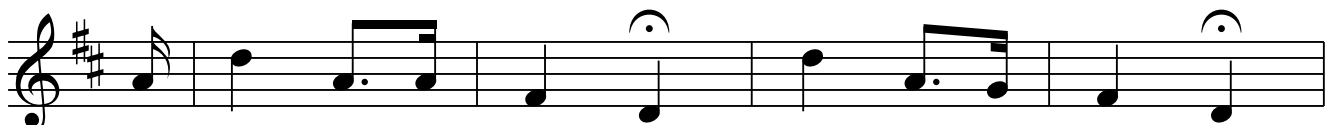
O, I'll sing you two. O What is your two, O?



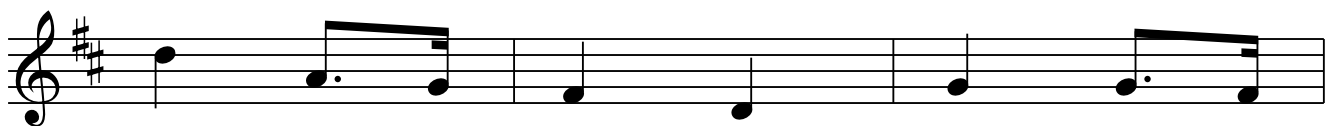
